### Kawasaki Good Times World Reopens

Kawasaki Good Times World is the corporate museum of the Kawasaki Heavy Industries Group. It highlights the origins of Kawasaki and the group's history, showcasing products encompassing the land, sea, and air and demonstrating how they have made significant contributions to society.

The majority of the visitors to our museum are children. In order to create an atmosphere they would find more enjoyable, we reorganized and renovated the displays to provide children with an up-close look of robots at work in places many have never seen, such as automotive, food, and semi-conductors factories. One corner of the museum features a "performing robot" that stands three meters tall. Behind this robot is a second robot, which attaches arms to the "performing robot". These arms help transform the robot into a humanoid guide which provides explanations about the features of different robots. Following these explanations, a picking robot and clean robot provide fun demonstrations for the kids to enjoy. Kawasaki Good Times World is great fun for families. 

### Global Service Training Session on Painting System

The Global Service Section of Kawasaki Robot Service, Ltd. provides technical support that focuses on enhancing the skills of the service staff and agents working at sales offices located in other countries.

We recently held this year's first global service training session, which was designed to help develop the skills of service staff that work on the Kawasaki painting robot systems shipped and operated all around the world. Personnel from Germany, the USA, Canada, Brazil, Thailand, Indonesia, and South Africa took part



in a 10-day training session which began on July 23rd, 2012 and featured training equipment provided by Kawasaki Robotics (USA), Inc. The session set out training items and skill maps of different service elements that participants were to master by the end of the 10-day period. The session was a great success, and all the participants were able to achieve the training target score of at least 80%.

In addition to this session, we are also planning to conduct training on spot-welding applications in the beginning of September, as well as a session on clean robots in early October. Through these training sessions, we aim to further enhance the skills of our personnel and help them become more comfortable performing different applications.
